Cautious, Partial Re-Opening

Since May 31, we have begun our cautious re-opening of our sanctuary. For those who are medically vulnerable, elderly or sick in any way, we ask you to forego attendance until risk subsides. For all others, we will strictly adhere to Diocesan safety procedures, which restrict worship and fellowship for some time. We ask your full cooperation and patience in following the procedures below:



- All participants must wear facemasks, no exceptions. Masks will be provided at the door for those without. While singing in choir or altar, masks may be lowered.
- Participation in the altar & choir will be limited; by invitation only
- Pews will be marked for social distancing and ushers will facilitate compliance
- Church will be sanitized before worship and sanitizer provided throughout sanctuary
- Communion will not be offered, kiss of peace will not be passed
- Children in attendance must stay with parents in church.
- There will be no post-worship fellowship inside or outside the church or hall.
