
So far, we have 108 pledges for \$172,165 towards 2025. May the Lord bless all our offerings!

Mambre Voskanyan, the pastor of St. Sargis Church in Stepanavan, Armenia. Fr. Mambre's daughter Gayane has a rare birth defect in her leg whose only treatment in Armenia is amputation. Frs. Hovnan & Mambre applied to Shriner's hospital for alternatives. By God's grace, Gayane was accepted, and is arriving for reconstructive surgery in St. Louis this July!
